



After the grand success of the 6th edition of Paperex South India 2022, held in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, it is our great pleasure to announce the 7th edition of Paperex South India, which is scheduled to be held at the Chennai Trade Centre, Nandambakkam, Chennai, on December 5-7, 2024, with the aim of introducing state-of-the art technologies at the doorstep of Indian Paper, Packaging, and Allied Industries and also to highlight the realities and new opportunities of the industry. Besides, the Paperex South India conference and exhibition aims to provide pulp, paper and allied industries with the opportunity to maximise business collaborations nationally and internationally while also showcasing their strengths in technology, product development, services, etc.



Indian Paper Industry - Present Scenario

The paper industry in India registered a growth of about 6.5 percent by the year 2023–24, and it is expected to grow the industry at a rate of 7–5% during the years 2024–25. Among various business segments within the paper industry, the packaging industry has fared well across segments such as the pharma sector, FMCG, and growth of the e-commerce business, which have played a major role in the growth of this segment. However, looking into the overall projected forecast of the Indian paper industry, it is offering better business opportunities to technology suppliers to find genuine buyers to induct state-of-the-art technologies, which can bring overall growth to the industry. Around 15% of the world population lives in India, which consumes only 5% of the total paper produced in the world. India's growing FMCG sector and high spending in education, as well as more health-conscious people, etc., are triggering factors in the growth prospects of the Indian paper industry, particularly the packaging industry in India, which is expected to grow by 12–15%. The projected demand for paper in the country is around 35 million metric tonnes by the year 2030, up from the present production of 23.5 million metric tonnes. To meet this project demand, the Indian paper and packaging industry has to adopt world-class state-of-the-art technologies to ensure product quality and also to compete with the world's major paper-producing companies, which are enjoying more technological and fibre-rich advantages than Indian mills.
